<b>Degree Requirement:</b>	▶ Minimum undergraduate degree
<b>Experience/Background Requirements</b>	▶ Minimum 10 years of substantive business experience with a minimum of five years at the senior management level. ▶ Each applicant's employment history will be reviewed to ensure that the applicant has the applied experience necessary to succeed in this challenging program
<b>Program Design</b>	▶ Combination of classroom and online delivery ▶ Completed over 18 months, divided into two nine-month terms: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Term 1</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Focuses on competencies in financial accounting, management accounting, finance, taxation and information technology</li> <li>• Incorporates weekend group-work sessions as well as individual online work and assignments</li> <li>• Assessment is based on assignments, group-work participation and communication</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Term 2</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Includes further in-depth and advanced accounting studies along with one of two career option choices in corporate or government financial management</li> <li>• Mainly online work, discussions and cases</li> <li>• Assessment based on case-work in CGA-Canada's Professional Applications capstone courses: Issues in Professional Practice (PA1) and Strategic Financial Management (PA2)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
